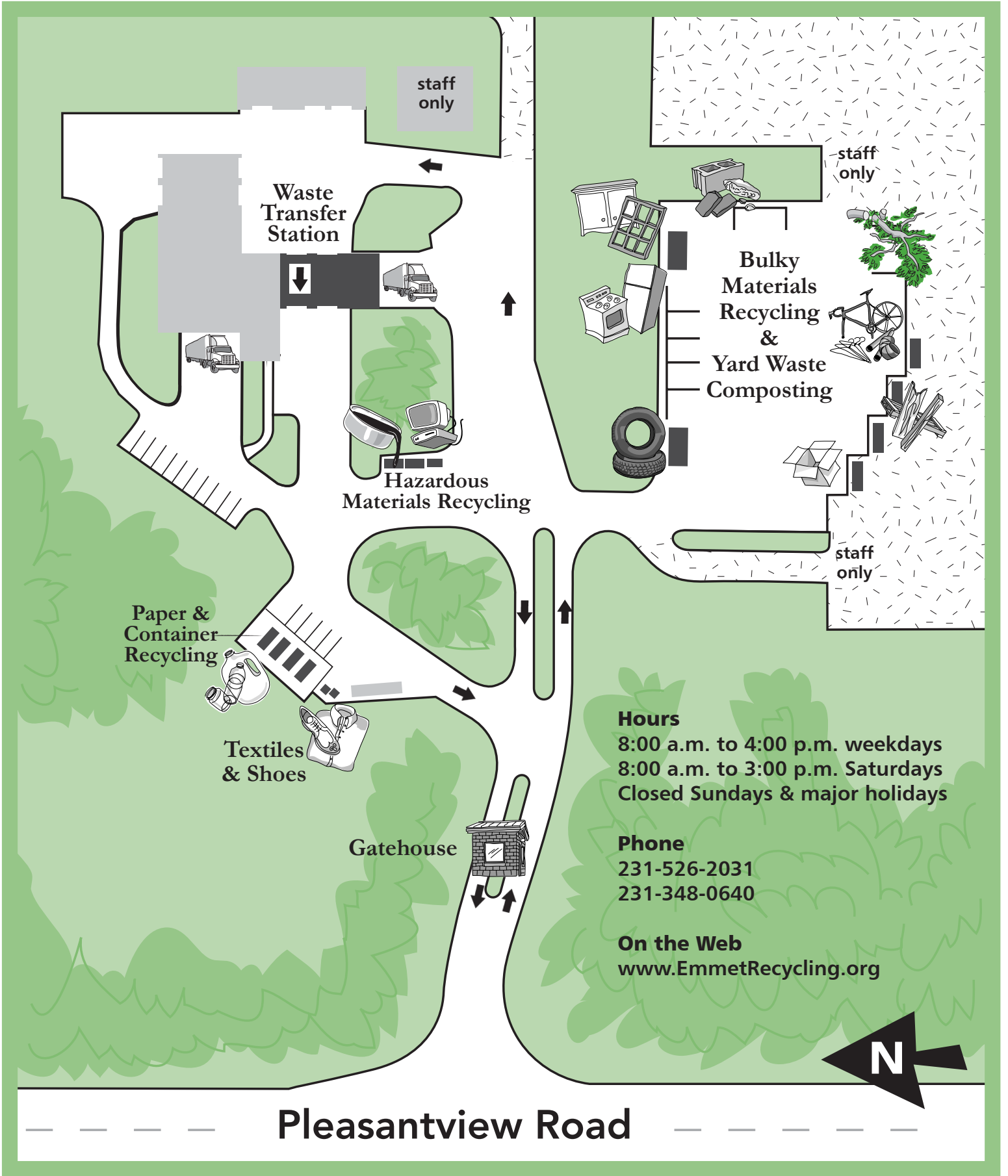

If you wish to bag your compostables, use **30-gallon paper yard waste bags** (available at hardware stores).

No plastic bags allowed.

This facility receives NO county tax dollars! Transfer Station fees fully cover disposal costs. Free Recycling for Emmet County residents is funded by the sale of recyclables and, when the market value of the materials doesn't cover all costs, by Transfer Station revenues. Free Household Chemical Drop-off is funded by Transfer Station revenues. So, when you dispose of garbage in Emmet County—whether at the Transfer Station or through a private hauler using our facility—you get 3 services for the price of 1: solid waste disposal, comprehensive recycling, and household chemical disposal. And all at one of the lowest gate rates in the region!
